

Treatment


- o 6 surgeries
- o 6 rounds of chemo
- o 6 weeks of radiation
- Out of pocket costs for treatment: over \$20,000

Logistics

- Disruptions in ability to enjoy regular tasks
- Countless trips to doctors offices & time off of work and away from loved ones

Challenges •

- o Lost my fertility
- Many other side effects that still affect my daily life
- Financial impact of surrogacy: \$150,000



 Cervical cancer screening typically starts at age 21 or 25. Think you're overdue? Don't wait.


Get Vaccinated.

 The HPV vaccine is given in 2 doses starting as early as age 9.









HPV VACCINE = CANCER PREVENTION.

- O NOT STI PREVENTION. HELP ELIMINATE THE STIGMA.
- EXAMPLE SCRIPT: "This vaccine is proven to reduce the risk of certain cancers. You are due for it today, shall we include it with your other vaccines?"

MY APPROACH TO WELLNESS & CANCER PREVENTION





6 THINGS I WOULD TELL MY YOUNGER SELF (BESIDES WEAR A HELMET)

- 1. Listen to your body. You know it best.
- 2. Find and stick with friends that feel like sunshine. And partners who will show up like sunshine, too.
- 3. Love yourself enough to take good care of yourself. Be mindful of what you consume (news, podcasts, food, all the things).
- 4. Don't wait until you experience a life changing event to demonstrate empathy towards others.
- 5. The sun will come out again tomorrow. You deserve sunshine.
- 6. Set reasonable boundaries on your time and energy your to do list will likely never be complete, and you must get comfortable with that.






Adolescent **Immunization** Schedule -Now Available in Somali!




HPV Administrations among 9-10 year olds by calendar year, Washington state




HPV Administrations among 11-12 year olds by calendar year, Washington state



HPV Administrations among 13-17 year olds by calendar year, Washington state




Percent of HPV-initiated (1+ dose) adolescents by age group, June 2019 - December 2024





Youth HPV work in Oregon



"Youth HPV Champions is an student-led initiative supported by OHSU Knight Cancer Institute, aiming to increase awareness of HPV prevention among the youth through conference summit events designed to train students to take steps to advocate for HPV prevention among their peers. Youth HPV Champions seeks to not only normalize, but also encourage discussions about HPV to contribute to the global effort in eliminating HPV infections, and thus, the global cancer burden for future generations."

Past Work - (Pre-Youth HPV Champions)

Youth HPV work in Oregon

- Health Awareness Club

- World Cancer Day events
- Organized the HPV Action and Awareness Summit
 - 7 School districts (100+ sign ups)
 - 2 Keynote speakers,
 - 3 workshops sessions (youth advocacy training, legislative, & social media approaches for advocacy)







Executive Council Role Description



- Sub-committees (conference, social media, ambassador, community events, & toolkit)
 - Conference: Organizing event schedules, meeting with speakers, developing workshops
 - **Social Media:** Utilizing our platforms of TikTok and Instagram to promote our work
 - **Ambassador:** In charge of organizing ambassador meetings and are in charge of delegating ambassador tasks to the rest of the EC
 - **Community Events:** In charge of organizing and finding events in the community for us to attend as well as sending out emails
 - **Toolkit:** In charge of a almost "manual" that guides other youth on how to promote HPV work in their schools/environments





Now that we have an established Executive Council...

We need **Ambassadors**. Selected through a filled out application form we created.

We currently have 18 ambassadors representing 15 schools

Ambassadors are essentially the liaison between schools and the executive council. Ambassadors are tasked with:

- Forming a Youth HPV Champions Chapter/Club at their respective schools and garner interest and awareness in HPV advocacy
- In charge of figuring out their members to attend our events (conferences, summits, etc.)
- Attending the annual conference and tabling there, showing the work they've done in their chapter
- Attend community events (optional, but encouraged)

YOUTH HPV CHAMPIONS AMBASSADOR APPLICATION

Youth HPV Champions Ambassadors are highly motivated individuals who work in liaison with high schools and the executive council to create immersive experiences at their respective high schools that empower youth to take ownership of their health, equipping them with the knowledge, resources, and confidence to make informed decisions regarding HPV prevention. 




